RESOLUTION 2009-02

PREAMBLE to resolution ordaining the restriction of parking along residential streets near Eagle Elementary School:

Eagle Elementary School has ample parking on the East lot for parents who pick up their children after school. Many parents, however, park along East Avenue and Andrew Street causing numerous citizen complaints about congestion, traffic flow and concern for the safety of kids walking home along that route.

WHEREAS, the Village of Eagle is concerned for the safety of children walking home from school along that route and surrounding streets and,

WHEREAS, there have been citizen complaints about traffic congestion and accessibility of residential drives and property, and


WHEREAS, the Village of Eagle wants to limit congestion caused by vehicles parked, stopped or standing on the affected residential streets near the school,


THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Eagle Village Board of Trustees does hereby ordain that:

1. It shall be illegal to for any vehicle to park, stop, or stand:
  - a. On East Avenue, east and west sides, between the hours of 2:30 p.m. and 3:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, from Main Street to Lawrence Street.
  - b. On Andrew Street, north and south sides, between the hours of 2:30 p.m. and 3:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, from Schroeder Avenue, east to the dead end.

The penalty for infractions of this resolution shall be the same in procedure and consequence as those found in Village of Eagle Code Chapter 4 section 4.30 and 4.31.
