Notice to voters: If you are voting on Election Day, your ballot must be initiated by two election inspectors. If you are voting absentee, your ballot must be initiated by the municipal clerk or deputy clerk. Your ballot may not be counted without initials. (See end of ballot for initials.)

If you make a mistake on your ballot or have a question, ask an election inspector for help. (Absentee voters: Contact your municipal clerk.)

To vote for a name on the ballot, fill in the oval next to the name like this: ●

To vote for a name that is not on the ballot, write the name on the line marked "write-in" and fill in the oval next to the name like this: ●

In the Presidential Preference Vote:

- You may vote only ONCE.
- If you vote more than once, your choices will not be counted.

Special Instructions for Presidential Preference Vote

Choose the party in which you will vote. Within the party you have chosen, you have ONE of 3 choices:

- Vote for a person whose name is printed on this ballot in the party you have chosen
- Vote for an uninstructed delegation from Wisconsin to the national convention of the party you have chosen.
- Write in the name of another person to become the presidential candidate of the party you have chosen.
