Approved Minutes

1. **Call to Order/Open Meeting Requirements:** Called at 6:00 pm, requirements were met.
2. **Roll Call:** Present were chair Salmela, Neuburg, Schoessow, Tegen and Chief Ehlers
3. **Public Comment:** No residents were present, however, an email from Sharon Royston was shared with the committee members, the text of which is included on page 2 of these minutes.
4. **Review minutes of the 12-16-14 meeting for approval:** The minutes were approved (4-0) on a Neuburg/Ehlers motion. Schoessow abstained.
5. **Discussion/Action regarding the creation of a chicken-raising ordinance for the Village of Eagle:** Chair Salmela presented the results of his survey of residents within the village covering 25 plus homes with the findings that no person contacted wanted a chicken ordinance. Two committee members indicated that they want to raise chickens and 4 of members neighbors would potentially raise chickens as well. The 12/18/15 Chief Ehlers update to the draft ordinance was reviewed and several additional agreed upon changes will be implemented. A finalized version of the ordinance will be available at the next committee meeting. A chicken raising permit was prepared and presented by Neuburg and discussed by the members. An updated version will be available at the next meeting. Neuburg is also developing a required landlord permission slip to be used if a tenant would like to raise chickens. Both documents will be on file in the Village office should the ordinance be enacted.
6. **Discussion/Action regarding an update of the noise ordinance:** Chief Ehlers presented a Village of Eagle sample copy of an ordinance utilized in Frederick, Maryland. The sample ordinance will be reviewed by the committee members prior to the February meeting.
7. **Discussion/Action regarding chapter 22, Sex Offender Residency Restrictions:** Chapter 22, Section 22.05 (Distribution) resident awareness / distribution requirements were discussed with the outcome questioning the need for the entire paragraph. The need will be discussed at the next committee meeting.
8. **Discussion/Action regarding an update to Chapter 2, section 2.15 with respect to adding meeting absence penalties:** The village board has requested an attorney review of the subject section and the results are pending.
9. **New business to be discussed during future meetings:** The Sharon Royston request, attached.
10. **Adjournment:** The meeting adjourned at 8:20pm on a Neuburg/Tegen motion (5-0).
