UNAPPROVED MINUTES

1. **Call to Order/Open Meeting Requirements:** Called at 6:00, meeting requirements were met.
2. **Roll Call:** Present were chairman Salmela, Neuburg, Schoessow, Tegen, and Captain Lesniewski. Others present were Linda Fenus, and Scott Dooley.
3. **Public Comment:** Linda Fenus comments were with respect to the noise ordinance status and information within.
4. **Review minutes of the 2-18-15 meeting for approval:** Minutes approved on a Neuburg/Schoessow/ motion. Carried 3 - 0, Tegen abstained.
5. **Discussion/Action regarding an update of the noise ordinance:** An updated draft to the preliminary ordinance, dated 3-8-15, was reviewed by the committee, the format of which met the expectations of the members. Categorization of zoning districts I1, C1 and A2 was completed. Remaining to be updated/completed are to clarify the verbiage in paragraph (d) under Noise Prohibitions, removing (daytime only) under Exemptions paragraph (b2), the development of a variance permit and the associated procedure for obtaining a permit, and a procedure for reading the noise level to be placed in the Measurement section. Technical adds are in regard to the length of time for the read, and the inclusion of the maximum noise level within the permit, ie, 85 dba being the choice discussed during the meeting.
6. **Discussion/Action regarding the creation of a chicken-raising ordinance for the Village of Eagle:** The committee approved submitting the 3-2-15 Salmela update of the draft ordinance to the Village Board via a Neuburg/Schoessow motion which carried on a 3 to 1 vote.
7. **Discussion of request submitted by Mark Marzion for development and authorization for parking signs on his building:** It was determined that, after review of the requirements under Wis. stat. 346.53, item (4), the parking signs are not legal as parking in front of a driveway is not allowed.
8. **Discussion of items to be placed on Village Board and/or future code & ordinance agendas:** The Domestic Fowl ordinance as developed and approved by the committee will be submitted to the Village Board at the April 9th meeting.
9. **Adjournment:** Meeting adjourned at 7:10 pm on a Tegen/Schoessow motion. Motion carried 4 - 0.
