- 1. Call to Order / Open meeting law requirements:** Meeting was called to order at 6:00 pm, meeting requirements were met.
 - 2. Roll call:** G. Scheff, M. Rice, Chief Russ Ehlers. Also in attendance Sgt. Gwen Bruckner & Sharon Royston. K. Dagenhardt – Absent.
 - 3. Review Minutes, May 6th & May 28th:** Tabled until August 5th meeting.
 - 4. Citizens Comments:** Sharon Royston wanted to know why there was no Police Booth at KMDays. Chief Ehlers stated that his contact at the EFD said that they ran out of time to set one up. S. Royston questioned the EPD's hours of operation (Office & Patrol). Chief Ehlers and Sgt G. Bruckner explained the scheduling. The EPD's phone system needs to be looked at. Does not work properly to transfer calls to an on duty officer.
 - 5. Discussion of Calls Received/Investigated by Chief Ehlers.**
 - 6. Police Bldg. update:** Chief Ehlers will send the Village of Eagle Residents an informational letter explaining the proposed building which will be attached to the old Village garage located behind the EFD.
 - 7. 5 Year Strategic Plan for the EPD:** Chief Ehlers presented the committee with an outline for the 5 year plan. The plan will be completed by the end of 2013.
 - 8. Discussion of more patrolling at highly populated places such as our school, village hall & the industrial park.** Sgt. G. Bruckner will place these areas into her schedules. The EPD has always made their presence at our school, but will increase it. Chief Ehlers showed his presence at our school during the Sandy Hook Incident to insure the children & teachers of our concern for their safety.
 - 9. KMDays Recap:** A few arrests were made. The EPD responded as the professionals they are and maintained their presence without further incident.
