The Town of Mukwonago and Village of Eagle Police Departments are seeking citizens who are interested in exploring the world of law enforcement. The second annual Citizen's Police Academy (CPA) class will begin Thursday, September 17, 2015. The Citizen's Police Academy classes will take place each Thursday from 6:00 p.m. to approximately 9:00 p.m. for 9 weeks. The Academy is free of charge and conditionally open to all citizens of the Mukwonago, Eagle and surrounding areas.

Citizens taking part in the Academy will learn in a hands on environment and gain an appreciation for what it is like to be a police officer. Classes and training include but are not limited to:

- Self -defense and handcuffing
- Traffic stops and traffic laws
- OWI and Drugged Driving enforcement
- Emergency responses
- Computer Crimes and Identity Theft
- Fire and Police rescue operations
- Current Drug trends and much more

Space is limited and citizens will be selected on a first come first served basis. In order to be accepted into the CPA class you must be 18 years of age and have no felony record nor recent misdemeanor convictions, domestic abuse convictions or any current restraining orders naming you as the respondent. Agencies reserve the right to deny entry based on criminal history or prior law enforcement contact.
