Officer Emanuele,

This letter of Commendation is in recognition of your efforts on June 25, 2017, after the closing of Kettle Moraine Days, in which your observations and follow through resulted in the saving of a subject in a life threatening situation.

A highly intoxicated subject had somehow crawled partially into a drainage culvert near the playground equipment in the Village Park. You observed suspicious movement and went to investigate. This resulted in you finding the subject lying face down in approximately one to two feet of water, who was struggling to keep his face above the water and was unable to remove himself from this dangerous situation. You called for assistance from the police and fire departments. You and Corporal Glaze entered the drainage culvert and were able to pull him from the water and began to provide initial care until he was transferred to the fire department's care. The subject's father, who had responded to scene, thanked you for saving his son's life as he was unable to care for himself in the situation he had found himself in. I was notified of your life saving actions by both other police officers as well as members of the fire department.

For your quick actions on that day, you are being recognized with this letter of commendation and will also be issued a life saving award pin.


Corporal Glaze,
