WIS 59 to US 18

Eagle - Dousman

Project Update

Project Overview:

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation is planning a 10-mile pavement resurfacing project on WIS 67 between the Villages of Eagle and Dousman in Waukesha County. Construction is scheduled for 2022 and will begin in the spring/summer. Through traffic will be detoured for the duration of the project, but access will be maintained to the Kettle Moraine State Forest and all residences and businesses.

Proposed Improvements:

- Mill and replace 2-2½ inches of existing deteriorated pavement.
- Remove and replace outdated and damaged signs.
- Remove and replace outdated or damaged beam guard sections and end terminals.
- Install High Friction Surface Treatment (HFST) on three curves between County ZZ and Piper Road to improve safety.
- Re-install center line rumble strips.



This project had originally been planned as a reconstruction project and was shared at a 2015 Public Information Meeting. In 2017, an updated project information mailer was sent to inform stakeholders that WisDOT had reduced the project to a pavement resurfacing project. The design team investigated impacts to environmental areas, crash data, real estate, public feedback, construction costs, and traffic volumes that lead to this decision.

This project remains a pavement resurfacing project which will extend the pavement life and improve ride quality.

Traffic impacts:

- WIS 67 will be closed to through traffic from WIS 59 to US 18 for the duration of project.
- Local access maintained at all times.
- Through traffic detour US18 - WIS83 - WIS59.
- Short-term full closure from County ZZ (West) to County X for high friction surface treatment installation.
